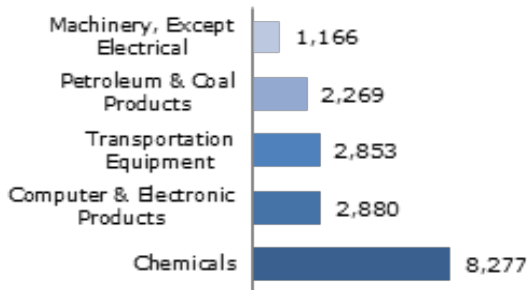

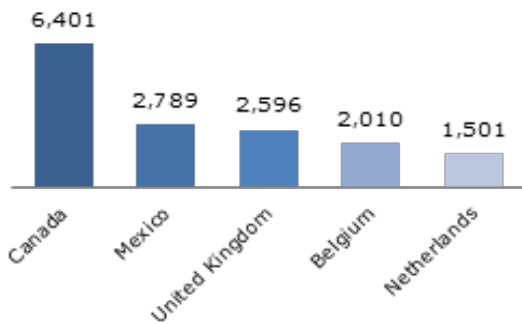

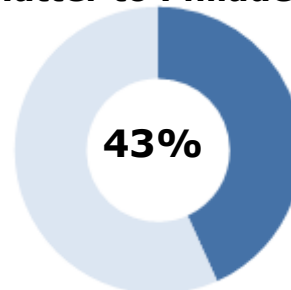

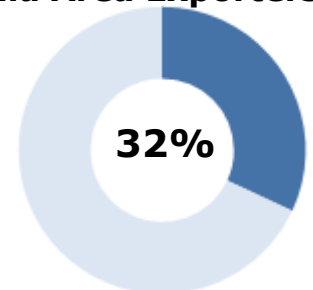

Share of merchandise exports to Trans-Atlantic Trade & Investment Partnership (T-TIP) members

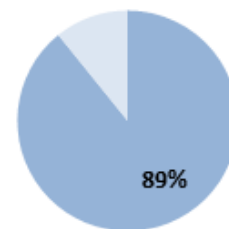

- In 2014, Philadelphia was the 11th largest metropolitan area exporter in the United States, with merchandise shipments totaling \$26.3 billion. This is up \$1.4 billion (5.6 percent) from the \$24.9 billion in merchandise exported in 2013.
- In 2012 (latest data available), 7,500 companies exported goods from the Philadelphia metropolitan area. Of these, 6,689 were small- or medium-sized exporters (SMEs) with fewer than 500 employees.
- Counties from the Philadelphia metropolitan area that reported exports in 2014 included: New Castle County (\$7.2 billion), Montgomery County (\$4.2 billion), Philadelphia County (\$3.1 billion), Gloucester County (\$2.9 billion), Chester County (\$2.5 billion), Delaware County (\$1.9 billion), Camden County (\$1.6 billion), Bucks County (\$1.2 billion), Burlington County (\$1.0 billion), Cecil County (\$468 million).
- In 2014, Philadelphia's top export markets included Canada (\$6.4 billion), Mexico (\$2.8 billion), United Kingdom (\$2.6 billion), Belgium (\$2.0 billion), and Netherlands (\$1.5 billion). In addition to these markets, Philadelphia also ranks among the major metropolitan area exporters to Germany, Switzerland, Italy, Turkey, and Sweden.
- Top export sectors from Philadelphia in 2014 were chemicals (\$8.3 billion); computer & electronic products (\$2.9 billion); transportation equipment (\$2.9 billion); petroleum & coal products (\$2.3 billion); and machinery, except electrical (\$1.2 billion). Philadelphia is also a major metropolitan area exporter of fabricated metal products; processed foods; plastics and rubber products; primary metal manufactures; and electrical equipment, appliances, & components.
- In 2014, Philadelphia benefited from existing trade agreements, exporting 42.6 percent of merchandise exports to free trade agreement (FTA) partners.
- In 2014, Philadelphia exported \$9.2 billion in goods to the NAFTA region and \$292 million in goods to the CAFTA-DR region.
