Mission participants will also benefit from networking events and logistical support provided by the GSGP South East Asia Trade Office.

WHY VIETNAM & THE PHILIPPINES?

- Vietnam and the Philippines have a combined population of 200 million.
- South East Asia markets are growing at over 7 % a year.
- Vietnam and the Philippines offer export opportunities in many sectors including: industrial, agriculture, Hardwoods, ICT and environmental.
- Over the last 10 years, U.S. exports to Vietnam increased by 330%.
- In 2020, the U.S. and Vietnam will celebrate 25 years of diplomatic relations.



COSTS

Participation Fee:

\$1,500 USD per person (each additional participant \$500 USD)

Market Research & Customized Appointment Setting Fees*:

Vietnam: \$3,000 USD

Philippines: \$3,000 USD

*Grant funding is available in many states to offset mission costs and travel fees. In some states, the market research and customized appointment fee are complimentary.
