

Biographical Information for Ron Anderson

Ronald C. Anderson is the dean of the Fox School of Business and the School of Sport, Tourism and Hospitality Management at Temple University. Anderson served as interim dean from July 2018 through his appointment as dean, effective July 1, 2019. Previously, Anderson was the Chair of the Finance Department at the Fox School.

Since his appointment, Anderson launched the school's Strategic Planning Initiative aimed at charting a new path for the school and the Diversity, Equity and Inclusion Initiative.

He has taught finance at the school since 2012. As a faculty member, he focuses on the field of corporate finance with an emphasis on the relation between managerial actions and firm value and a research focus on corporate governance.

After earning a BS in engineering from the University of Pittsburgh, Anderson worked at Schlumberger Limited, a Paris- and Houston-based oilfield services company. The company sponsored his MBA from the University of Pittsburgh. After 11 years at management and executive positions in the United States, Africa, Europe and South America, Anderson pursued his PhD in finance at Texas A&M University. Anderson held several faculty appointments, including at American University from 1999-2012.
